## Summer course:

# THE SECRET OF THE NORDIC MODEL AND FUTURE EUROPEAN CHALLENGES, 5 CREDITS

This summer course aims to increase your historical knowledge and understanding of the Nordic countries' modern welfare structures.

The focus of the course will be on the Nordic collaboration's role in handling the large social challenges which a globalised world entails. The course is based on the Nordic model – the combination of a developed welfare system and market economy structures.

Participation in the course gives you as a student an opportunity not just to study the Nordic Model but also to meet and discuss with students from different parts of the world. During Europaforum - an arena for issues within European politics, science, trade, industry and culture, you will have the opportunity to speak to politicians, institutions, companies and civil society organisations from the Nordic countries and EU.

### Three components

- Literature on the Nordic model and its history.
- Seminars and further specialisation as well as study visits in the region, among other things, to the Nordic Council in Copenhagen.
- Work with interviews and participating observations at Europaforum's activities. At the end the work will be reported in a written paper.
